

Emiri Decree No. (56) of 1971

Regarding Granting Citizen Students Studying in Evening Literacy Schools

We, Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, Ruler of Abu Dhabi,

Based on the proposal of the Minister of Education and the approval of the Council of Ministers, we have ordered the following:

Article One:

Citizen students studying in evening literacy schools, who maintain an attendance rate of 75% or more throughout the academic year and successfully pass the year-end examinations, shall be granted the following rewards:

| Level | Rewards |
|------------------------------|------------------------------|
| First Year Literacy | 30 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Second Year Literacy | 40 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Third and Fourth Primary | 50 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Fifth Primary | 60 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Sixth Primary | 60 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| First and Second Preparatory | 80 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Third Preparatory | 85 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| First and Second Secondary | 100 Bahraini Dinars per year |
| Third Secondary (Tawjihi) | 100 Bahraini Dinars per year |

Article Two:

This decree shall be effective from the date of its issuance and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
